In case of inclement weather, recycling pickups may be CANCELLED. The next collection will be two weeks later on your regularly scheduled day. Sign up for weather-related alerts at co.somerset.nj.us/alerts.

Holidays that will affect recycling collection in 2021 are as follows: New Year's Day 2021 (Jan. 1); Memorial Day (May 31); Independence Day (July 5); Labor Day (Sept. 6); Thanksgiving Day (Nov. 25); Christmas Day (Dec. 24); and New Years Day 2022 (Dec. 31). If your usual pickup day falls on one of these holidays, your collection will be rescheduled to the following weekday.

SOMERSET COUNTY CURBSIDE RECYCLING HOW-TO GUIDE

DUAL STREAM TOTE PROGRAM

FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED TWO-WHEELED RECYCLING TOTES.

The Somerset County Recycling Division is phasing in this program one area at a time. Residents will be provided with two 65-gallon wheeled recycling totes over the next few years. Each tote has a different color lid (yellow and lime green). Stickers on the lids indicate what materials are to be placed in the totes.

Regular scheduled pickups with the new totes will begin on your next scheduled recycling date after delivery of totes.

The tote with the **lime green lid** is for the cardboard and paper products, and the tote with the **yellow lid** is for commingled glass, cans, and plastic materials.



Accepted items are as follows for the paper tote (lime green lid): Newspapers, inserts, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, envelopes, paperback books, corrugated cardboard, colored paper, clean pizza boxes, office and school papers, shredded paper (loose), chipboard boxes including cereal, cookie, pasta, cake, cracker, detergent (remove plastic liners), gift, shoe, shirt and any retail boxes, paper egg cartons, paper bags, books (hard covers must be removed), phone books, non-metallic gift wrap and greeting cards.

Accepted items are as follows for the commingled tote (yellow lid):

Aluminum, steel and bimetal cans, glass bottles (all colors), glass jars (all colors), plastic bottles and containers #1 - #7 (Examples: water, soda, milk, juice, soap, detergent, bleach, shampoo, and cleaning-agent bottles). You may also include peanut butter, yogurt and diaper-wipe containers, margarine tubs, plastic trays and clear plastic clamshell containers from restaurant salad bars.



20-GAL. BLUE BUCKET PROGRAM

FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS IF YOU ARE STILL USING THE SMALLER BLUE 20-GALLON RECYCLING BUCKETS.

GLASS BOTTLES, ALL PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS (#1 - #7), STEEL, BIMETAL & ALUMINUM CANS

These items should be rinsed thoroughly and placed inside your recycling bucket. Crush all plastic bottles to save space. Remove caps. Acceptable items:

- Glass bottles (all colors)
- Glass jars (all colors)
- Steel cans
- Bimetal cans
- Aluminum cans
- All plastic bottles and containers #1 - #7 **NO STYROFOAM®**

#1 - #7 Examples:

Water, soda, milk, juice, soap, detergent, bleach, shampoo and cleaning-agent bottles. You may also include peanut butter, yogurt and diaper-wipe containers, margarine tubs, and clear plastic clamshell containers from restaurant salad bars.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, CHIPBOARD & PIZZA BOXES

Corrugated cardboard must be cut into 2 ft. x 2 ft. squares and tied with string or twine. Please include pizza boxes & chipboard with corrugated cardboard. Place tied bundle (pizza boxes, chipboard & cardboard) next to your recycling bucket. Acceptable items:

- Brown bags
 - Chipboard boxes including: cereal, cookie, pasta, cake, cracker, detergent (remove plastic liners), gift, shoe, shirt and any retail boxes. Poster board & backing from writing pads also accepted.
- Corrugated cardboard
- Paper towel rolls
- Pizza boxes (clean!)
- Tissue boxes

Make sure all recyclables are as clean as possible to deter pests & odors.

OTHER PAPER/JUNK MAIL ·

Other paper should be placed in a brown paper bag or cardboard box and placed **next to** your blue bucket. Shredded paper must be in clear or labeled plastic bags. Acceptable items:

NEWSPAPERS

Newspapers must be bundled and tied with string or twine. Place tied bundles next to your blue bucket. Acceptable items:

- Shredded paper

- Inserts that come w/newspapers, such as comics, glossy coupons, TV/magazine sections & colored food/store ads
