

Borough of North Plainfield
Dog Licenses

New Jersey State statute requires owners of dogs (7 months of age or older) to license their dogs annually. The dog owner must show proof that a licensed veterinarian administered a rabies vaccine to the dog (Rabies Vaccination Certificate). The Rabies Vaccination Certificate shall prove that the dog has been inoculated against rabies with a vaccine having duration of immunity which extends throughout at least 10 of the 12 months of the licensing period. Dogs with duration of immunity against rabies that expires prior to the tenth (10th) month of the licensing period shall be revaccinated prior to issuance of a license.

If you have never licensed a dog in the Borough of North Plainfield, you will need to provide a valid NJ Driver's License or NJ Issued ID and the following information:
