ORDINANCE NO. 20-07

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 7A OF THE BOROUGH CODE, ENTITLED “TRAFFIC SCHEDULES”, MOST NOTABLY SECTION 7A-2, ENTITLED “SCHEDULE II: NO PARKING”

WHEREAS, Section 7-3.4 provides that “[n]o person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule II of Chapter 7A”; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough finds it necessary and appropriate to amend, revise and supplement Schedule II of Chapter 7A regarding no parking on certain sections of Mountain Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield be amended, revised and supplemented as to Chapter 7A, entitled “Traffic Schedules”, most notably Section 7A-2, entitled “Schedule II: No Parking”, as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Sides</u>	<u>Location</u>
Mountain Avenue	b. North	From the east curbline of Somerset Street extending [150] <u>175</u> feet east therefrom.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect, after final passage, twenty (20) days following action or inaction by the Mayor as provided by law or an override of a mayoral veto by the Council, whichever is applicable and publication in accordance with law, unless a resolution is adopted, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b)*, declaring an emergency and providing that this Ordinance shall take effect at an earlier date.
