

**NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE**  
**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**

that at a virtual meeting of the Board of Health of the Borough of North Plainfield held on November 17, 2020 there was introduced and read for the first time, and passed on such first reading, an ordinance, a true copy whereof is printed below and that said Board did then and there fix the regular meeting of said Board of Health to be held on December 14, 2020 at 7:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, and the Borough Council Chambers, 263 Somerset Street, North Plainfield, New Jersey as the place when and where said ordinance will be further considered for final passage, at which time and place, or at any time and place to which such meeting shall from time to time be adjourned, all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance.

The said ordinance as introduced and passed on first reading as aforesaid is in the following words and figures:

**ORDINANCE NO. HO 20-01**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 26, ARTICLE X, SECTION 26-10 OF THE BOROUGH CODE, ENTITLED “MASSAGE, BODYWORK AND SOMATIC THERAPY ESTABLISHMENTS,” MOST NOTABLY SUBSECTION 26-10.8, ENTITLED “OPERATING REQUIREMENTS”**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Board of Health finds it necessary and appropriate to amend, revise and supplement Chapter 26, Article X, Subsection 26-10.8 of the Borough Code regarding the operating requirements for massage, bodywork and somatic therapy establishments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Health of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield be amended, revised and supplemented as to Chapter 26, Article X, Section 26-10, entitled “Massage, Bodywork and Somatic Therapy Establishments,” most notably Subsection 26-10.8, entitled “Operating Requirements,” so as to add a new paragraph k, which shall read as follows:

“k. All massage, bodywork and somatic therapy establishments shall maintain a list providing contact information for all clients, which shall be made available to the Board of Health upon request for the purpose of contact tracing if necessary.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect, after final passage, twenty (20) days following action or inaction by the Mayor as provided by law or an override of a mayoral veto by the Board of Health, whichever is applicable and publication in accordance with law, unless a resolution is adopted, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b), declaring an emergency and providing that this Ordinance shall take effect at an earlier date.
